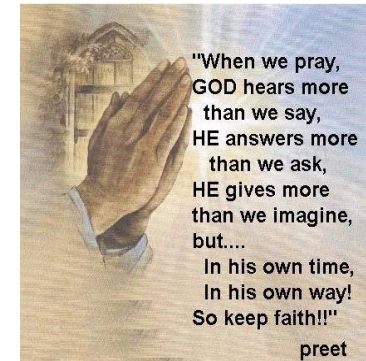

The reason that we do not realize greater help is because there is lack of earnest, fervent devotion.
