"The self-examination, the confession of sin, the reconciling of differences, has all been done. Now you come to meet with Christ. You are not to stand in the shadow of the cross, but in its saving light. You are to open the soul to the bright beams of the Sun of Righteousness. With hearts cleansed by Christ's most precious blood, in full consciousness of His presence, although unseen, You are to hear His words, "Peace I leave with you, My peace I give unto you...
